#### **2026 AISIA OCEANIA KENDO FEDERATION**

#### Q: Which 20 Countries are in this Federation?

A: (East Asia) Japan, Sth Korea, China, Taipei, Hong Kong, Macau, Mongolia (Asean)Thailand, Indonesia, Malay, Philippines, Malaysia, Singapore, Vietnam, Cambodia, Myanmar, Brunei, Lao (Oceania) Australia, New Zealand

#### Q: Why do we want a new Federation?

A: The AJKF was a member of GAISF which was part of a recognized Alliance which no longer exists, the new organization is AIMS (Alliance of Independent and recognized Members of Sport.) has a new criterion for acceptance.

AIMS Criteria

- Part of 3 or more Continental Federations
- Good Governance.

FIK is part of two federations this will create the 3rd.

#### Q: What are the Benefits of the IOC recognition of AIMS?

A: Help Kendo gain recognition and promotion in countries where Kendo is a minor sport.

Also as AIMS is a part of the IOC (International Olympic Committee) so countries may get funding, however it is made clear that there is NO consideration of Kendo becoming an Olympic Sport.

### **KENDO ADMIN UPDATE**

#### CLG (COMPAMY LIMINTED GUARANTEE) update

- On the 18<sup>th</sup> August 2025 the required Notice of 35 days will be sent to all States and Territories Kendo Associations's
- At the AGM on the 11<sup>th</sup> Oct in NSW we will cast the final vote, which is expected to pass as we have agreed and paid a subject expert to prepare all the relevant documents
- Prepare the necessary paperwork to be submitted to ASIC and the membership for approval to become a Company Limited by Guarantee

#### Rationale for the Resolution

The Committee proposes this change to ensure the Australian Kendo Federation adopts a nationally consistent and contemporary legal structure better aligned with the Federation's operations and future growth. A Company Limited by Guarantee offers enhanced governance, limited liability for members, and is the preferred structure for national sporting organisations and not-for-profits.
